Shopping Spree Restrictions

The participant may only push/pull one cart at a time and may not receive help from any other individual. Only items collected and contained within the cart without assistance by the participant or any other person at the conclusion of the sixty (60) second period will be counted as part of the prize.

The participant may collect a maximum of one (1) of any eligible items in his/her cart during the Shopping Spree excluding lottery, tobacco, pharmacy products and gift cards.** The exact retail value of each Shopping Spree depends on the total value of eligible items collected by the winner but may not exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
